# HOT ISSUES

## **Workforce/Entry Level Housing - Position**

CSMAR is in support of market value owner-occupied workforce/entry-level housing. This housing is defined as market rate housing provided by the private sector. Builders who are offered zoning, density bonus, and ability to build smaller unit size can produce owner-occupied workforce/entry-level housing in our service area. Owner-Occupied workforce/entry-level housing is the most desperately needed in the areas we serve.

## **Why CSMAR is in favor of Workforce/Entry Level Housing**

- There is a desperate shortage of housing in all the cities and counties which we serve.
- Because of growth control ordinances including general plans, zoning, and burdensome permitting process, fees and conditions - it has been very difficult or impossible to build owner-occupied workforce/entry-level housing.
- A review by government agencies on how to provide owner-occupied workforce/entry-level housing should be a priority.
- Any real economic growth as well as stability in our service area will be closely connected to providing owner-occupied workforce/entry level housing.
- Companies looking at our service area to expand their business or start new businesses are and will look to housing for their employees as a priority before expansion or relocation.
